CALL FOR APPLICATION

FOR TRAINEES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MOBILITIES PLANNED DURING THE PROJECT

Within the framework of the BEST VET project the partners open a call for application addressed to all the students/trainers enrolled in professional training paths in the following fields of training:

- Culinary arts (cooks and waiters)
- ICT (computing and communication)
- Electricity and Electronics
- Administration, management and commerce

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible the applicants must be enrolled as students/trainees in one of the above mentioned fields of training at one of the following participating schools:

- 1. IES Angel Corella [Spain]
- 2. Escola Profissional Gustave Eiffel [Portugal]
- 3. GO! Atheneum Emanuel Hiel Schaarbeek-Evere [Belgium]
- 4. GO! Atheneum Ukkel [Belgium]
- 5. COOVI Secundair Onderwijs [Belgium]
- 6. GO! Technisch Atheneum Zavelenberg Sint-Agatha-Berchem [Belgium]
- 7. AFP Colline Astigiane [Italy]

Selection process

The Italian partner AFP Colline Astigiane is responsible for the collection of the applications from all partner countries on its own website and will forward the list of the received application to each participating school.

To apply, the candidates must go the AFP Colline Astigiane webpage (English Version) at the following link

Step 1:

Once ready to apply the candidates must fill the application form by clicking on the button:

Application form

To be eligible, the application form must be carefully filled in all its parts, including the "motivation











section, to be filled in English only.

Once the application is completed press the button "send application". A page will appear with the application reference number to be kept and saved by the applicant.

Step 2:

Once the application is submitted, the student will receive an automatic message on its email account with the invitation to fill in an English Test.

By clicking on the link provided in the automatic email received, the student will be redirected to the English test page. The test is **made up of** 25 questions (4 points each question). Scores up to 60 points identifies language skills of A1 level, scores from 61 to 89 points identifies language skills of A2 level, scores from 90 to 100 identifies language skills of B1 level.

At the completion of the English test, the Italian Partner will forward the results to each participating school, that will proceed with further analysis of the application that may include personal interviews and evaluation of the training performance, including behavioral aspects.

Each participanting school will then identify the winning students and will publish the list of the awarded applicants and a reserve list.

Deadlines for application

For mobility n. 1 to be held in Belgium (referred to as C1 in the project application as awarded by the granting authority) applications and English test must be completed by December 10th, 2017

Application open to Spanish, Italian and Portuguese students

Mobility dates: February 25th - March 3rd 2018

For mobility n. 2 to be held in Spain (referred to as C2 in the project application as awarded by the granting authority) applications and English test must be completed by March 10th, 2018

Application open to Italian, Belgian and Portuguese students

Mobility dates: April 22nd – April 28th, 2018

For mobility n. 3 to be held in Portugal (referred to as C3 in the project application as awarded by the granting authority) applications and English test must be completed by October 1st 2018

Application open to Italian, Belgian and Spanish students

Mobility dates: to be defined in November 2018

For mobility n. 4 to be held in Italy (referred to as C4 in the project application as awarded by the granting authority) applications and English test must be completed by February 1st, 2019

Application open to Belgian and Portuguese students

Mobility dates: to be defined in March 2019











The number of mobilities per country is:

6 for Spain,

8 for Portugal,

8 for Belgium

4 for Italy.

Content of the mobilities

The mobilities will be organised on a 5 working days + 2 travel days basis

During the working days the following activities will be organised by the hosting Country based on shared ideas with the sending Schools.

- 1 full day of cultural activities (in some cases split into 2 half days): these may include visits at local museums, local historical and artistic heritage sites + activities aiming at mixing and identifying cultural differences and to appreciate, accept and tolerate them
- 1 full day of visits at local companies in the fields of training involved in the mobility (in some cases split into 2 half days) These will include the understanding of the production processes, the needs of the labor market in terms of skills and competences and how private companies can participate to the students learning process.
- 3 full working days in the laboratories of each participating school to learn the different ways of working, different teaching techniques and how training works in a different context (geographic and economic context)

Accommodation

To allow a proper understanding of the local cultural tradition, the participating students will be accommodated at host families in the country of destination on a full board basis.

Wherever and whenever it won't be possible, students will be accommodated at apartments or youth hostel and will receive a pocketmoney allowance to cover meal expenditures.

The Grant

Each sending school will deliver a subsistence grant to the participants on their bank accounts equal to 375 euro. The students will pay 200 euro to the host family or to the apartments/hostel owner to cover the hospitality costs and will keep 175 euro for their own personal expenses
